This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 2 achieving PM Reading benchmarks from 25% in 2016 to 60% in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN U2B from 33% in 2016 Year 3 Reading to 50% in 2017 Year 3 Reading.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN U2B from 12.5% in 2016 Year 5 Reading to 50% in 2017 Year 5 Reading.
- 80% of students in Year 3 will achieve National Minimum Standard for Reading.
- 80% of students in Year 5 will achieve National Minimum Standard for Reading.

- Refine the school reading framework and embed it as the shared language of teaching and learning Reading in our school.
- Increase teachers' and teacher aides' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching Text Processing and Comprehension across all learning areas.
- Writing U2B initiative for Year 4/5 via IMPACT Centre Project – Booster Just Write (Round 1 – 2017).
- Numeracy U2B initiative for Year 4/5 students via IMPACT Centre Project – Booster Solve It (Round 1 – 2017).
- Writing U2B initiative for Year 2/3 via IMPACT Centre Project – Booster Just Write (Round 3 – 2017).
- Numeracy U2B initiative for Year 2/3 students via IMPACT Centre Project – Booster Solve It (Round 3 – 2017).
